Lesson 2: Chapters 5-7

Dream Big:

- Drawing a prayer circle means there is no escape clause, no **expiration** date!
- Too often we let **how** get in the way of **what** God wants us to do. We can't figure out how to do what God has called us to do, so we don't do it at all!

God's Generosity...Exodus 16:11-16

- God doesn't just provide in dramatic **fashion**; God provides in **dramatic proportion**.
- And when you draw God size prayer circles, it gives the **Omnipresent** One room to work.

Well Sir, Well Sir...Matthew 14:13-21

- Lord do something **unpredictable** and **uncontrollable!**
- We ought to want the Lord to **perplex** us! Instead of operating by faith, we switch back to our default setting of **logic**.
- If you put the little you have in your hand into the hand of God, it won't just add up; God will make it **multiply**.

Is there a limit to my power:

- Our biggest problem is our **small** view of God.
- Until you come to the **conviction** that God's grace and power know no limits, you will draw small prayer circles.
- If your vision isn't perplexingly **impossible**, then you need to expand the radiuses of your prayer circles.

Key Thought: "God's arms are not too short!"
